SUBJECT

READY RESERVE FLEET (RRF) ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURES

This amendment incorporates a procedure to adjust final billings to U.S. Navy (MSC) so as to reflect the actual costs of operation of RRF vessels based upon final audit reports received from the Office of the Inspector General.

Accordingly, the basic order is revised as follows:

Section 2.02 (Office of Ship Operations) is revised by adding a new subsection 9:

"9 Initiate billing adjustments to reflect actual costs as set forth in final audit reports."

A new subsection 2.04 3 is added, as follows:

"2.04 3 The Office of Financial Approvals shall provide the Office of Ship Operations (action copy) and applicable Region Finance Office (information copy) copies of final audit reports of activation and operation of RRF vessels."

In addition, the organization titles in Section 2.04 are revised to change "Office of Financial Management" to read "Office of Accounting."
