A Reliable Waterway System Is Important to Agriculture	This regularly updated factsheet describes the importance of marine transportation to agricultural exports, which were a record \$136.3 billion in calendar year 2011, providing a \$37.4 billion trade surplus to the American economy, with imports at \$98.9 billion. Forestry and fishery products, and critical farm inputs such as fertilizer, feed, and fuel move on the waterway system as well. The U.S. Agency for International Development (USAID) administers Titles II and III of the Food for Peace Act. USDA administers the remaining food aid programs.
